Majura FC Coaching Course Reimbursement Policy

Purpose

To support the professional development of our volunteer coaches, Majura FC will reimburse the cost of specific coaching courses upon successful completion and continued coaching commitment. This policy outlines the reimbursement process and requirements for various coaching courses.

Policy Statement

Majura FC values the dedication and development of our volunteer coaches. We recognise the importance of continuous education and professional growth in enhancing the quality of coaching provided to our players. To support this, Majura FC will provide reimbursement for select coaching courses, the course description is contained in **Attachment 1**.

Majura FC will facilitate the MiniRoos certificate annually, this is a free course run by Capital Football.

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Football Coaching Course Description

MiniRoos

MiniRoos is aimed at volunteer parents and coaches working with novice players or players aged approximately up to ten (10) years old. The session is entirely practical and encourages the coach to create games based on enjoyment. The focus is on learning by playing football. The secret to encouraging players to develop a love for the game without coaching is to organise enjoyable football activities. The coaches' exposure to fundamental game rules and guidance on creating an enjoyable and safe football environment.

Football Australia Foundation of Football

Aimed at volunteer parents and coaches working with advanced beginner to competent level players or players aged up to approximately fifteen (15) years old. This course is a prerequisite for the Football Australia/AFC C Diploma. Coaches will participate in practical sessions covering the basics of techniques as well as learning about basic playing principles of the game. The course is mostly practical and not graded, allowing the student to participate in the training sessions if they so choose. The course also promotes participating in group discussions with the goal of exchanging experiences.

Football Australia/AFC C Diploma

Aimed at coaches working with advanced beginner to competent level players or players aged approximately twelve (12) years of age and above. The course is designed to provide a logical connection to the Foundation of Football Certificate covering in greater detail:

1. The technical aspects of the game, including teaching the basics of passing, receiving, and dribbling with the ball, as well as defending strategies.
2. The principles of coaching and comprehension of the principles of play; and
3. The concept of teaching behaviour using various sorts of practise methods.

Football Australia/AFC B Diploma

Aimed at coaches working with players who are able to play football at a standard where they can confidently pass and receive the ball and scan for information, aged approximately twelve (12) years of age and above. The focus of the course is on teaching players how to use techniques and combine with each other to apply the principles of attack when the team is in possession and the principles of defence when the team is out of possession. Coaches are assessed while coaching players in opposed practices and small sided games up to 8 vs 8.

To register for the B Diploma, a coach must be:

- In possession of a valid Football Australia/AFC C Diploma (or international equivalent) and have held the C Diploma for a minimum twelve (12) months.
- Minimum eighteen (18) years of age.



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Football Australia/AFC A Diploma

Aimed at coaches working with highly competent to expert players aged sixteen (16) and above. The focus of the 'A' Diploma is to analyse the different ways teams apply the principles of attack and defence. Reference is made to research data to provide coaches with information that will challenge assumptions and influence strategic thinking when preparing teams to play. Coaches are assessed on their competency to coach players 'in the game' involving 9 v 9 to 11 v 11 practices.

To register for the A Diploma, a coach must be:

- In possession of a valid Football Australia/AFC B Diploma (or international equivalent) and have held the B Diploma for a minimum twelve (12) months.

Football Australia/AFC Professional Diploma

Aimed at coaches working with highly competent professional players. An intensive course with distance learning and post-course assignments. Four key themes— leading oneself, leading others, leading culture, and the business of football—are central to the course. Leadership, both on and off the field, and managing the demands of being a professional coach are heavily emphasised throughout the course to better equip students to handle the intricacies of the role.

To register for the Pro Diploma, a coach must be:

- In possession of a valid Football Australia/AFC A Diploma (or international equivalent) and have held the A Diploma for a minimum twelve (12) months.
